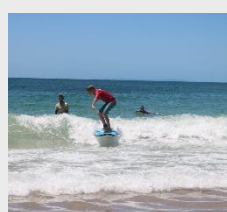




Our Lady of the Rosary School Caloundra Annual Plan 2021
